# Summary of the Meeting of the Technical Advisory Committee on Science and Knowledge - June 9, 2020

**Virtual Meeting** 

## **Meeting Objectives**

The three main objectives of the June 9 meeting were to: 1) Determine 2 to 3 priorities and deliverables for the committee to focus on over the next year; 2) Identify a research contract that could advance a Committee priority; and 3) Lay out the next steps, topics and timelines for collaborating with the Indigenous Advisory Committee.

These discussions were preceded by an update by the Agency and followed by a brief discussion of follow-up actions to be taken.

### Agenda Item: Brief Remarks from the Agency

- An Agency official provided an update to the Committee on three topics: strategic assessment, scoping, and follow-up, which were discussed at the Committee's March 3-4, 2020 meeting.
- The Agency's ex-officio member provided an update on the Regulations Respecting Excluded Physical Activities (Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Exploratory Wells).

## **Agenda Item: Committee Priorities**

- The co-chairs led a discussion on deciding the committee's priorities for fiscal year 2020-21.
- The committee agreed that it would focus on 2 4 strategic priorities. A
  key consideration in selecting priorities would be that they respond to
  Agency needs, in areas where the Committee can provide the most
  value.
- A subcommittee is to be established to further articulate potential priorities, which would then be confirmed or adjusted by the full TAC.

## **Agenda Item: Research Contract**

- The co-chairs led a discussion on deciding whether the Committee would issue a research contract to support its work for 2020-21 and the potential topic the contract would address.
- The Committee agreed that the strategic priorities for 2020-21 would first need to be decided, before the topic for any research contract could be determined.

# Agenda Item: Collaboration with the Indigenous Advisory Committee

 The Committee agreed to hold two joint meetings with the Indigenous Advisory Committee over the summer to promote cross fertilization of the committees' work and determine joint areas of interest.

## **Decisions Made**

- The Agency will provide further detail on how Committee input is incorporated into products.
- The Committee will focus on 2 4 priorities for 2020-21.

- The Committee will decide its priorities before deciding on any supporting research contract.
- The Committee is aiming to hold two virtual joint meetings with the Indigenous Advisory Committee over the summer.
